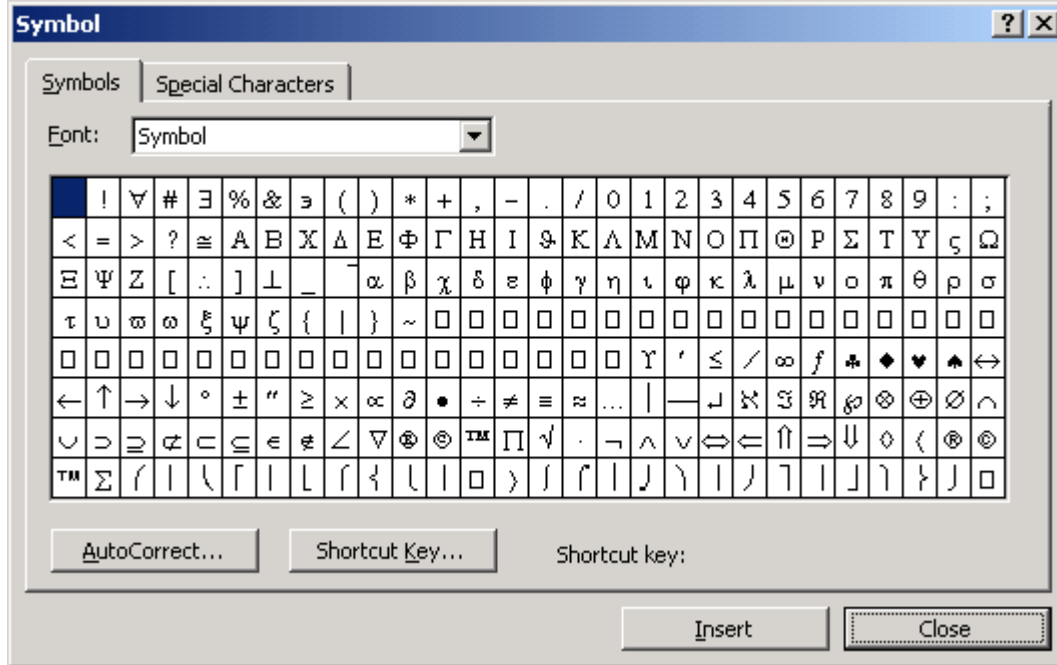


Keyboard Shortcuts for Some Math and Logic Symbols

The Insert Symbol feature of Microsoft Word can be used to make expressions look neat and professional. It offers you the following palette:



But using Insert Symbol does slow you down. So for the following common symbols, feel free to use the following shortcuts:

For this symbol	which means	you can type this:	Remarks
\leq	less than or equal to	<code><=</code>	Just as in Java, C++, etc.
\geq	greater than or equal to	<code>>=</code>	
\neq	not equal to	<code>!=</code>	
\wedge	and	<code>^</code>	Shift-6
\vee	or	<code>V</code> or <code>v</code>	That's the letter v – but be careful if you are using v as a variable at the same time.
\rightarrow	implies	<code>--></code>	That's two hyphens and a >. Some versions of Word will automatically convert this to \rightarrow .
\leftrightarrow	if and only if	<code><--></code>	That's less than, two hyphens, greater than. If you type four hyphens instead of two, it might get converted to \leftrightarrow .
